



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. WHAT ARE THE PRIZES?

Grand Prize - Custom built \$1.25 million Fiorante home in Wascana View and \$25,000 cash

Early Bird Prize - worth over \$72,000

2010 Cadillac SRX

\$25,000 cash

Tickets must be purchased by April 29th to be eligible for the early bird draw.

There are 1,853 prizes in total. Other prizes include brand-new vehicles, vacations, sport & leisure prizes and home electronics. For more details regarding the prizes visit www.hrfHomeLottery.com.

2. HOW MUCH ARE TICKETS?

Tickets are \$100 each or 3-pack for \$250

3. WHEN ARE THE DRAWS?

Early Bird ticket sales deadline: Thursday, April 29th

Early Bird Draw: Tuesday, May 11th

Final ticket sales deadline: Thursday, May 20th

Final Draw: Tuesday, June 1st

In order to be eligible for the Early Bird Draw, tickets must be purchased before the Early Bird ticket sales deadline of midnight, April 29th. In the event that all 37,000 tickets are sold by the Early Bird ticket sales deadline, then all 1,853 prize draws will be completed by May 11th.

In the event that tickets remain after the Early Bird ticket sales deadline, then only the Early Bird Draw will be made on May 11th. Ticket sales would continue until the final ticket sales deadline of midnight, May 20th. The remaining 1,852 prize draws would be completed by June 1st.

Each ticket purchased before the Early Bird ticket sales deadline is eligible for all 1,853 prizes. Tickets purchased after the Early Bird ticket sales deadline are eligible for the remaining prizes.

4. WHEN IS THE SHOWHOME OPEN?

Showhome hours: Opens March 13th

Weekdays: 6 pm – 9 pm

Weekends & holidays: Noon - 5pm

5. HOW WILL PROCEEDS BE USED?

Proceeds from the Hospitals of Regina Foundation 2010 Home Lottery will support the purchase of bedside monitors for intensive care units and other essential equipment for Regina's hospitals.

6. HOW ARE WINNERS NOTIFIED?

All winners are notified in writing by Deloitte with an official letter explaining what they have won and how to claim prizes. A list of all winners will be published in the Leader Post and will be posted online at www.hrfHomeLottery.com within one week of the applicable draw date.

7. CAN SOMEONE WHO LIVES OUTSIDE OF SASKATCHEWAN OR OVERSEAS BUY A TICKET?

This lottery is intended for residents of Saskatchewan. Out-of-province supporters may purchase tickets if they are in Saskatchewan at point of purchase. In this instance tickets can be mailed out-of-province.

8. WHAT HAPPENS IF I CANNOT PICK UP MY PRIZE IN PERSON?

Arrangements may be made to have a prize shipped to you freight collect. Arrangements can also be made for someone else to claim your prize with your written approval and proper identification.

9. WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF A "BAD" PAYMENT WAS MADE FOR A TICKET (I.E. NSF CHEQUE)?

Only tickets that have been paid for and/or have been verified as paid for are eligible to be entered for the respective draw(s). A minimum of one week is allowed between our ticket sales deadline and the date of the draws. This time period allows for all forms of payment to be verified and processed. If for any reason a payment is returned, the ticket will be deemed invalid if payment cannot be made prior to the draw.

10. IF I WIN, IS MY TICKET STILL IN FOR OTHER DRAWS?

Yes, after each draw (including the Early Bird draw) the winner is recorded and the ticket number returns for the next draws.

11. IS MY TICKET PURCHASE TAX DEDUCTIBLE?

No. Because lottery winnings are not taxable, lottery tickets are not tax deductible.

12. DO I HAVE TO TAKE MY PRIZE AS IS OR CAN I JUST TAKE THE CASH?

Prizes must be accepted as awarded. There are no cash substitutes.

13. IF I WIN A HOUSE DO I HAVE TO LIVE IN IT OR CAN I SELL IT?

Once a home is awarded to a winner and the title is transferred, they do not have to move in. Any prize can be sold if the winner wishes to do so.

14. IF I SELL THE HOUSE (OR ANY OTHER PRIZE) DO I HAVE TO PAY TAX ON THE SALE AMOUNT?

No. Lottery winnings are not taxable in Canada (including any cash prizes).

15. IS THERE CAPITAL GAINS TAX ON THE HOUSE IF I SELL IT?

No. Winning a house is a lottery prize, not a capital gain. Lottery winnings are not taxable in Canada.

16. IF I WIN A VACATION PRIZE BUT CANNOT TRAVEL CAN I JUST TAKE THE CASH?

No. Although travel prizes ARE TRANSFERABLE so you may give it or sell it to someone else.

17. HOW LONG DO I HAVE TO CLAIM MY PRIZE?

All prizes must be claimed within 120 days of the applicable draw date. After 120 days and after all reasonable attempts to contact the winner have been made, unclaimed prizes will be returned to the Hospitals of Regina Foundation for further fundraising use, subject to Saskatchewan Liquor & Gaming Authority approval.

18. HOW OLD DO YOU HAVE TO BE TO PURCHASE A TICKET?

Persons of any age may purchase a ticket; however, if the winner is under 18 years of age, the prize may be delivered to the purchaser's guardian or the public trustee.

19. ARE THE PRIZES DONATED?

No. All prizes are purchased by the Foundation using the tender process.

20. HOW CAN MY CHANCES OF WINNING REALLY BE 1 in 20?

Each ticket is entered in the lottery for ALL draws. There are 1,853 prizes and only 37,000 tickets available. 1 chance in 37,000 tickets x 1,853 draws equates to approximately 1 chance in 20. (For a more detailed explanation of the mathematical equation please refer to the Program Director.)

21. INQUIRIES REGARDING TICKET PURCHASE (i.e. have not received official ticket in the mail; spelling or address error(s); etc.)

22. WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE A TICKET?

The following and their immediate families are not eligible to purchase a ticket: directors, trustees and staff of the Hospitals of Regina Foundation and partners and staff of the professional services firm of Deloitte & Touche LLP.
